



SPEED WEEK ENTRY PROCEDURE

Dear Member

Thank you for your Entry to compete at DLRA Speed Week. In order to make your participation as enjoyable as possible this is an outline of a few things you need to do to make this occur.

1: NEW VEHICLES All vehicles competing for the first time at Speed Week must have undergone at least one pre-inspection prior to coming to Lake Gairdner. The last thing we want to see is a new competitor turned away for non-compliance with rules and regulations. See contact details for inspectors and State Delegates below and arrange your inspection NOW!

2: RULEBOOK Get a copy of the DLRA Rule Book and read it carefully. This is the only way to make sure you and your vehicle complies with the necessary Technical and Safety Requirements to compete. If you are unsure see the list on the back. You can buy a hardcopy from the DLRA Office or download for free at <http://www.dlra.org.au/rulebook.htm>

3: IDENTIFICATION Make sure your Vehicle has the identical Vehicle Number and Class Details as shown on your entry form. You must have numbers affixed to your vehicle when you present for technical inspection.

- If the same vehicle is running 2 classes the second class will be distinguished by adding a 9 to the vehicle number. Displaying drivers name is optional.
- If the vehicle is being driven / ridden by a second or subsequent driver or rider, their member number MUST be displayed on the vehicle. Displaying drivers name is optional.

If you present a vehicle that does not have the correct numbers your vehicle will not be inspected.
Stay Safe and have a good Speed Week.

1.	<p>Complete vehicle technical inspection</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You must have logbook; new vehicles will be issued with a log book. If you don't have your current log book with you the Scrutineer will send you to the Registration caravan to purchase a new one. (\$50) • A DLRA Inspector will provide you with a vehicle inspection form; fill out your part. • Determine your 3 digit computer class code and 3 digit engine class from the rule book and enter it on the inspection form. Also write it down in your logbook! • Get in line and complete vehicle inspection. • After Inspection, move your vehicle to your pit area and <u>don't park blocking inspection lines</u> while completing the registration process.
2.	<p>Be a current (this year) member:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>All persons listed on the entry, as owners and/or drivers must be an active DLRA member before entry.</u> You can renew your subscription the DLRA at the registration caravan. • If you are already a member, please drag out your membership card.
3.	<p>Check the paperwork</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On the Entry form make sure all class details are complete. • Make sure entrant and drivers have signed the inspection form. • Have the driver fill out medical information form.
4.	<p>Come to registration window and complete registration.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have your DLRA membership card ready • Submit completed inspection form and entry form.
5.	<p>Arm Bands</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Driver and crew must have acknowledged that they have read the Speed Week Disclaimer and Release <p>Must wear wrist bands all week to drive and get onto lake; free exchanges.</p>



SPEED WEEK ENTRY PROCEDURE

ALL DRIVERS AND CREW must attend the drivers meeting held on the Sunday afternoon before Speed Week at 4pm in the Inspection area. For those that cannot attend there will be a Drivers meeting on the Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday if required at Race Control starting at 7am. All Rookie drivers and crew must attend Rookie Orientation, which will follow the drivers meeting on the Sunday and after the drivers meeting on subsequent days. Location and any time changes will be posted at the Registration Caravan.

In your entry package, you will find:

- x 4 Pit Pass wrist bands - these get you through the gate and onto the salt each day. You may purchase more at Registration caravan.
- x 2 Orange Push/Crew truck stickers, these allow your crew vehicles into pits and into the "restricted course" area. If you need more, they also may be purchased at the Registration caravan.

Please check to be sure that the above items are in your envelope, as no adjustments will be made after you leave the window.

You will be handed your "Inspected" sticker to place on your race vehicle at Scrutineering once it has passed.

All Race vehicles MUST have an "INSPECTED" sticker on them to run.

Please don't park blocking anyone's pit or the inspection lines!
