

MEDIA GUIDELINES AND INFORMATION DRY LAKES RACERS AUSTRALIA

- 1. Media must report direct to the Registration Caravan (located centrally in the pits) upon arrival on the salt. This is your point of information for Speed Week.
- 2. Media Passes are issued only to accredited photo journalists with sufficient proof of credential and/or letter of assignment. Film crews by prior arrangement only.
- 3. All registered Media must wear their issued yellow vests, identifying them as such.
- 4. Members of the Media are expected to cooperate with DLRA Officials and take direction as asked.
- 5. All Media are granted access to restricted areas, such as return roads etc. but must have a working UHF radio in their vehicles and have a hand held UHF radios on their person at all times
- 6. Media vehicles and photographers cannot be more than 15 meters from the return roads.
- 7. Be familiar with the racecourse layout. Please know where you are all all times. A track layout map will be issued to you on receipt of your vest from the Registration Caravan.
- 8. Watch your speed observe posted limits. Generally the speed limit on the return roads is 50 kph. Congested areas 30 kph. Speed in the pits is strictly 15 kph or walking pace.
- 9. No media vehicles are allowed in the staging lanes at the start lines.
- 10. Members of the media at the starting line must ensure that they do not interrupt race proceedings. Please take guidance from the Starters and Line Stewards.
- 11. Members of the media may visit the emergency vehicle posts at the 3 mile and the 6 mile; these are the closest positions to the track. Permission must be sought from the Race Director prior to visiting these locations. The Race Director will liaise with Emergency crews to determine the appropriate time as numbers of visitors are limited.
- 12. No member of the media may cross the racecourse at any time.
- 13. Media must leave the salt by the posted pit closing time, unless by arrangement.
